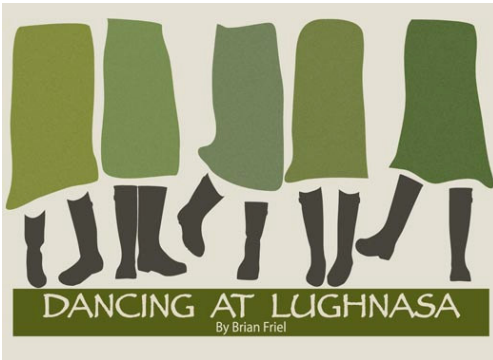

The Butler Did It Singing

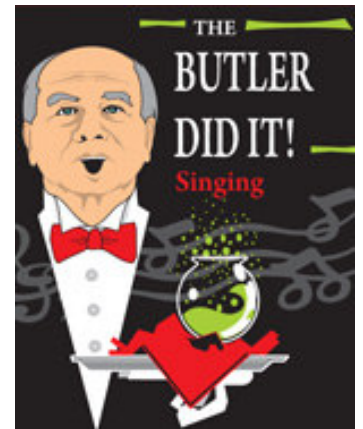

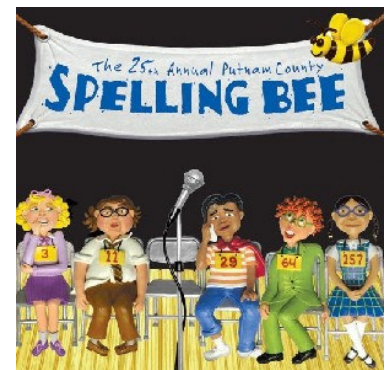
The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee
