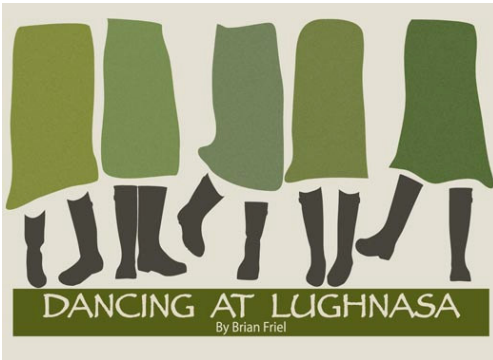

### Clue = The Musical

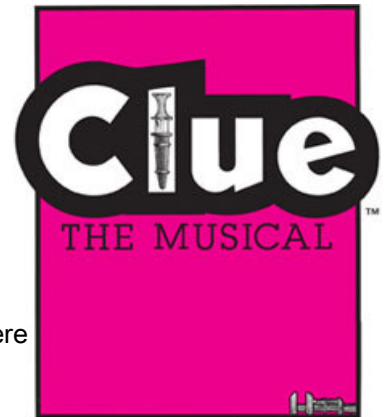

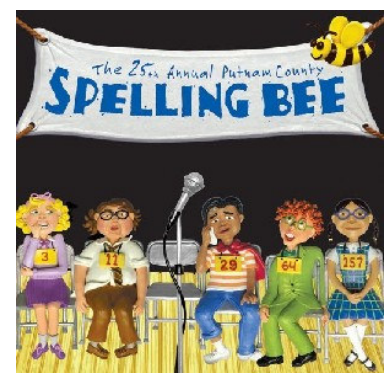
### The 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee
